BIG TIMBER (AP) — More than 100 highway fatalities last week in the state's north and west, with the death of two more persons, one a four-month-old baby from Libby.

Montana Highway Patrol officials identified the accident victims as Eugene T. Allen, 45, of Mullan, Tenn., and Sarah Cougill, four months of Libby.

A spokesman for the patrol said the two died Saturday in a severe accident one mile east of the Park County line in Sweet Grass County on U.S. 10.

The spokesman said an automobile driven by Walter Moore, also of Mullan, apparently went out of control on a patch of shaky, slick highway and collided head-on with an automobile driven by Grand Cougill of Libby.
