Two Die In Polson Crash

FOLSON — Two Polson residents died following a head-on collision at 6:30 a.m. today on U.S. 93 east of Polson near the South Shore Inn. Killed outright was Aaron A. "Archie" Coulter, 51, former sheriff of Lake County, Gary L. Ducharme, 20, died shortly after the accident at St. Joseph's Hospital. The two deaths bring Lake County's traffic toll for 1971 to 17, an all time record. Bill Phillips said an inquest will not be called. Both men

were alone in their pickup trucks. The two vehicles were mangled. The Montana Highway Patrol reported Coulter was northbound and Ducharme southbound. The accident occurred in the northbound traffic lane patrolmen reported. Coulter served as sheriff of Lake County from 1963 to 1967 and was succeeded in office by Phillips. Both bodies were taken to the Mosley Chapel where funeral arrangements are pending.

Officials Probe Death

Flathead area authorities are investigating aspects of the death of Leonard Dunham, 70, Oilmont. The former Toole County commissioner died Wednesday at the Kalispell General Hospital.

County Atty. James Otson said this morning, "According to initial reports I have at my office there are some possible questionable circumstances which require further investigation. The Kalispell Police Department is conducting that investigation to develop all facts.

"If there are circumstances which would require filing of felony charges, such charges would be filed. If the facts show it to be a civil matter then such action would be up to surviving relatives of Mr. Dunham. At this point in the investigation it is not possible to make such a determination," Otson said.

Otson did not establish circumstances or the identity of another elderly individual possibly involved saying, "To do so now would prejudice the investigation."
