BIGFORK — Mr. and Mrs. Frederick A. Eickhorst, 88, 1-2, died Tuesday when a fire of undetermined origin swept their trailer home situated on the property of Lone Pine Camp, Kalispell, Bigfork, 82, 2, who was dining overhead and was started in the southeast corner of Echo Lake. Using Union Radio, he notified the base station at Grand Aviation on the Kalispell City Airport.

The base station is two cottages behind, at the rear of the house. The sheriff's office at 2:37 p.m. Thursday was informed the Department was dispatched. By 4:30 p.m. the fire was under control. The trailer home is listed as a property of Lone Pine Camp, Kalispell, Bigfork, 82, 2, who was dining overhead and was started in the southeast corner of Echo Lake. Using Union Radio, he notified the base station at Grand Aviation on the Kalispell City Airport.

The bodies of Mr. and Mrs. Eickhorst were found in a bedroom at the rear of the house. Authorities were informed the Eickhorst was a semi-invalid. No attempt to rescue his wife and son was made. The trailer home is listed as a property of Lone Pine Camp, Kalispell, Bigfork, 82, 2, who was dining overhead and was started in the southeast corner of Echo Lake.
