Autopsy Will Determine Death Cause

YELLOW RAY — Lake County Coroner-Sheriff Bill Phillips has ordered an autopsy to determine the cause of death of Vernon W. Gibson, 68, Missoula, who died Thursday at his Yellow Bay summer home just south of the Holiday Resort.

Phillips says the elderly man was sitting in a chair at the end of the dock and toppled into the water. Bystanders quickly extricated him and began to apply artificial respiration. Deputy Sheriff Louis Hopke and the Bigfork Fire Department responded with a resuscitator but they were not able to revive Gibson.

The autopsy is to determine whether Gibson incurred a heart attack or was drowned. The incident occurred at 12:30 p.m.
