**Broadside Collision
Covers 100 Feet**

COLUMBIA FALLS — Mrs. Palma Johnsrud, 53, 235 First Ave. W., Columbia Falls, was instantly killed in a car-truck accident about 7:20 p.m. Saturday at Columbia Heights.

Authorities attributed the cause of death to a broken neck after her vehicle was struck broadside by a loaded grain truck driven by Frederick Priest, 28, Cour d'Alene, Idaho.

Her 12-year-old son Ronald was taken to North Valley Hospital. Ambulance attendants at first thought the boy was in serious condition because he was unconscious. Later doctors diagnosed a slight skull fracture and concussion and listed his condition as fair. He is expected to survive. He recovered consciousness and was aware of his name and the crash but he did not realize his mother had been killed.

It was the second tragedy in the Johnsrud family from vehicle accidents. Her husband George E. Johnsrud was killed in a pickup crash Oct. 1, 1967, about five miles south of Lakeside on U.S. 93 in Lake County.

Priest was westbound on U.S. 93 and he had slowed to about 5 miles an hour through the Columbia Heights area. Both he and his relief driver confirmed they saw the car approaching, slowing for the stop sign and men coming on across U.S. 2. Priest said, "When I saw her coming I veered to the left, but I wasn't sure she was going to make the stop. Then she came on across the road and the truck took the car dead center."

The truck, loaded with 60,000 pounds of feed barley, struck the car dead center under the flashing caution light at Columbia Heights. Momentum and dead weight of the truck pushed the car like a juggernaut nearly 100 feet off the roadway and into the gravel approach of the Mountain Shadow Motel.

One of the first persons to reach the vehicle was Walter Everin inside the cafe. He got in the car, felt for a pulse and could find none. He then assisted in removing the stunned boy from the passenger's side of the vehicle.

The imprint of the bumper and front of the truck were very apparent in the left side of the car. In fact it was mangled at almost exactly dead center. County Atty. James Olson said it is apparent there is no need for an inquest.

Mrs. Johnsrud is survived by three sons, the injured Ronald, George of Columbia Falls and Kermit of Havre. She is also survived by two brothers Ervin Oyster of Fort Benton and Kermit Oyster of Wolf Point. Her body was taken to the Van Leuven Funeral Home, Columbia Falls, where services are pending.

This was the second fatal accident in Flathead County within a week. Mrs. Linda Marvin, 19, was killed Monday in a single-vehicle accident just north of Glacier Park international Airport entry on LaSalle Road. She too died of a broken neck.

**Two Drown In
Holiday Mishaps**

Search and rescue teams today began efforts to recover the bodies of two drowning victims in Northwest Montana Monday.

Brian Jordan, 28, Libby, drowned Monday afternoon in Schoodicou Lake 10 miles west of Libby while attempting to swim to a raft.

James M. Richardson, 45, owner of Sunset Cabins, Bigfork, drowned about 7 p.m. in Flathead Lake south of Woods Bay following a boating mishap.

Lincoln County Sheriff John Fisher is heading a recovery party of a dozen men making the attempt at Schoodicou Lake. Flathead Undersecretary, Cecil Coombs headed the party of divers and boats which started the first search sweep from Bailey's Landing, Somers, at 10:30 a.m.

Fisher said Jordan was among a party of swimmers at the lake adjacent to Bull River Road. He was apparently struck by a cramp and went under the water before fellow swimmers could reach him. The mishap occurred about 6 p.m.

Blast Victim Dies At Missoula

MISSOULA (AP) — Richard Jorgensen, a 43-year-old Missoula businessman critically burned in the July 18 fire-explosion of his warehouse, died Saturday in a Missoula hospital.

Jorgensen's wife, Johase, 38, died shortly after an explosion ripped through the couple's Western Montana Wholesale Grocery Co. warehouse on Missoula's northwest side.

Firemen have not determined cause of the reported \$1 million-\$2 million fire.

Jorgensen had been hospitalized in St. Patrick Hospital's intensive care ward since the explosion.
