Victor John Kilstrom, 80, Kalispell, died in Kalispell Thursday. He was born May 26, 1891 in Sweden. As a young man he came to America and had lived in South Dakota. He had been employed as a telephone lineman prior to his retirement. He had been a resident of the Fishback Valley for about 15 years.

He was the son of the late John and Mary Kilstrom. He is survived by one son, Melvin Kilstrom, 52, Park, Texas, and several grandchildren. The body has been forwarded by the Johnson Funeral Home to the Montgomery Funeral Home at Alexandria, S.D., where funeral services and interment will take place at a later date.

Pinned Driver Dies In Crash

LIBBY — Russell E. Kimberlin, 36, Libby, was pronounced dead on arrival at St. John's Lutheran Hospital Thursday morning following a logging truck-dump truck accident 17 miles northeast of Libby on Montana 37.

His death is the 10th traffic fatality of the year in Lincoln County, now in a tie with the all-time high road death record in the county established in 1965.

Kimberlin was pinned in the cab of his dump truck between 30 and 45 minutes before two wreckers could pull the wreckage apart and free him. The accident occurred shortly after 8:30 a.m.

The Montana Highway Patrol reported Clayton H. Riddle, 29, was southwest on Montana 37 with a loaded logging rig. Failing to negotiate a right curve, Riddle's truck dumped with the load of logs spilling against the cab of the dump truck.

A few logs went under the front end of the dump truck but the near-fall force of the logs was against the cab of the truck. It forced into the guard rails and shoved those rails six feet out of position and pinning Kimberlin in the midst of the debris.

Would-be rescuers worked amid the pile of logs to attempt to save Kimberlin's life. Damage was set in excess of \$4,000 and investigation is still open. There is no decision from Lincoln County authorities whether an impact will be called into the fatality.

Kimberlin is survived by his wife and two children. He was a member of the Lutheran Church.
