PHILIPSBURG (AP)—Funeral services are pending for an 18-year-old Philipsburg girl who died in an Idaho Falls, Idaho, hospital Friday.

Debbie Lynn Neal died of injuries suffered in a motorcycle accident in West Yellowstone over the Fourth of July weekend. Miss Neal was taken to Sacred Heart Hospital in Idaho Falls with internal injuries.

She was a spring graduate of Granite County High School and was working at the Old Faithful Inn in Yellowstone National Park this summer.

Divers Recover Drowning Victim

HUNGRY HORSE—Divers early this morning recovered the body of Larry W. Neisinger, 19, Columbia Falls, from 30 feet of water at Lion Lake south of Hungry Horse.

Neisinger drowned about 10:30 p.m. Thursday. The recovery mission was completed at 12:10 a.m. today by Ed Trippett and Noble Dean of the Flathead Life Saving and Rescue Assn.

The youth was part of a group of young people who had gone to Lion Lake for a late evening swim. He had headed out from shore to a raft anchored out in the lake. When he attempted to climb on the raft it began to sink under his weight. Neisinger then attempted to swim back to shore and started to flounder.

Would he recover heard one faint call for help before he went under about 100 feet off shore. Len Ogle, off-duty Columbia Falls police officer, swam out to the point where Neisinger had disappeared. He made several attempts to dive for the body but was unsuccessful.

Returning to shore Ogle advised the Flathead County Sheriff's Office reporting the incident and calling for assistance. He then proceeded to pinpoint the spot as accurately as possible. Sheriff Curtis Snyder said, "This is the action which led to the quick recovery by the divers. They were able to go into the water and be fairly certain of an accurate location."

Neisinger is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Glenn Neisinger, Missoula; a brother, Raymond, Las Vegas, Nev., and a sister, Mrs. Charles Neisinger, Rt. 2, Kalispell.

WHITEFISH — A six-man seven miles west of Whitefish driving team of the Flathead Life Saving and Rescue Assn.
