|          |            | <p><b>Crash Injuries Fatal To Woman</b></p> <p>POLESON — A single-vehicle accident Sunday night near Idaho Bay has claimed its second victim. Mrs. Bettijeann Olmstead, 64, of Lake Shores, died late Monday night at St. Joseph's Hospital, Polson.</p> <p>Death was attributed to multiple injuries, concussion and exposure. She never regained consciousness after being extricated from heavy truck at the bottom of a 50-foot bank by the Polson volunteer crew about 8 a.m. Monday.</p> <p>She had been 55, was found dead by the wreckage after a Montana Highway Departmental section crew followed skid marks from Montana 30 and discovered the accident which authorities here estimated occurred about 10 p.m. Sunday when the couple was returning home from church.</p> <p>Coroner Sheriff Bill Phillips said there will not be an inquest. As nearly as authorities can determine they believe Olmstead may have swerved to avoid a deer on the highway and ended up in the fatal accident.</p> <p>Phillips said, "We have this area is a heavily traveled deer country. Both Olmstead and his wife were thrown clear of the wreckage. The car was smashed in its plunge over the bank."</p> <p>Her death sends the Lake County traffic fatality record</p> <p>for this year to 21, five ahead of last year's previous all time record of 15.
