Search and rescue teams today began efforts to recover the bodies of two drowning victims in Northwest Montana Monday.

Riste: Jordan, 28, Libby, drowned Monday afternoon in Schoolhouse Lake 16 miles west of Libby while attempting to swim to a raft.

James M. Richardson, 45, owner of Sunset Cabins, Bigfork, drowned about 7 p.m. in Flathead Lake north of Woods Bay following a boating mishap.

Flathead Sheriff Curt Snyder reported Richardson apparently fell overboard while on a trip from the Elks Resort Camp returning to Bigfork. According to Mary E. Staus, Billing, in the boat with Richardson, she felt a lurch. She turned around to see Richardson, arms wheeling, fall into the lake. She threw out a life jacket but he went under before he could grab the safety device.

She told authorities the craft had left the cabin about 9 p.m. on the trip across the lake to the Elks camp. They stayed at the resort for about 15 minutes and then began the return trip across the lake reaching the mouth of Woods Bay and then turning north when the accident occurred.

A witness on shore put out to the Richardson boat and secured the safety of Miss Staus.
