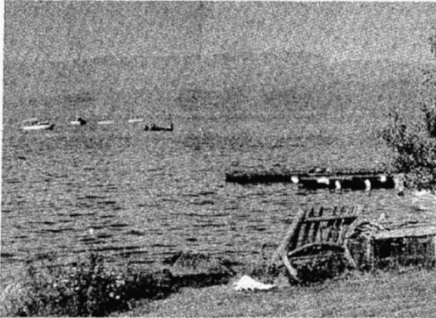

The divers were disappointed Sunday evening they had not made a fast recovery. They reported fairly good visibility, up to 20 feet at some points. As they worked a group of about six privately owned boats razed the search area and closed it off to boating traffic to give the divers a clear field to work.

Boats and diver teams pilled the area Sunday afternoon working from 5 to 8:30 p.m. until darkness forced them off the lake. During the whole period Sheriff Curt Snyder and Deputy Jack Labonte manned shorewise communication from the shore sighting points to the working boats towing divers on water sleds. There was a moment at 7 p.m. when the divers thought they had a contact but it did not prove out.

Search teams were back on the lake this morning slowly sweeping the sight line points with a radar buoy and an anaraz tube marking the approximate spot of the drowning. An aerial search was also made this morning with one possibility of a sighting marked with a buoy and divers checking out that aspect.

The divers were disappointed Sunday evening they had not made a fast recovery. They reported fairly good visibility, up to 20 feet at some points. As they worked a group of about six privately owned boats razed the search area and closed it off to boating traffic to give the divers a clear field to work.
