Logger Dies In Woods Accident

KILA—Walter L. Webster, 30, Columbia Falls, was instantly killed in a woods accident 10 miles south of Kila Monday morning. No inquest is planned according to Coroner-Sheriff Curt Snyder.
Webster was working in the Mount Creek cove with a skidder when the machine dug in on an uphill slope. When the skidder worked free it slid sideways down the hill, crashed into a tree and knocked Webster off with the machine rolling 2 1/2 times and passing over Webster crushing him.
The accident was witnessed by Dan Loutback, woods boss for Royal Logging Co. Webster had been employed by the firm since September 1968. He is survived by his widow Laura Lee, a son Walter Jr., 10, and daughter Vicki, 7; his parents Mr. and Mrs. Frank Webster, and a brother George, all of Columbia Falls.
