Bigfork Couple Die In Accident

SALINAS, Calif. - Mr. and Mrs. Hollis Young, East Lake Shore, were killed at 7:10 p.m. Friday in a two vehicle accident four miles north of Salinas on U.S. 101.

According to the California Highway Patrol, Young, 77, was westbound crossing U. S. 101 on Epitacio Road when his vehicle was struck broadside by a southbound car driven by Gary Jenks, 27, Salinas. Young and his wife, 74, were both pronounced dead on arrival at the Monterey County General Hospital.

Jenks was admitted for treatment as were three passengers in the Young vehicle, Mrs. Gladys West, 72, Mrs. Cindy Richards, 50, and Miss Anita Richards, 21, all of Salinas. Attending physicians say all four survivors are in satisfactory condition with Mrs. Richards and Mrs. West being treated for major injuries, Jenks and Miss Richards for minor injuries. All four are expected to survive.

Young had ranched and operated a business at Chinook. For many years the family had maintained a summer home on Flathead Lake a few miles south of Bigfork until selling their interest and maintaining a permanent home on East Lake Shore. They had also farmed for many years in the Creston area.

Funeral services and burial will be in the Flathead with arrangements being made by the Johnson Funeral Home. There are two surviving sons, Ted, Jackson, Ind., and James, Salinas.
