Grace Isaacs, 86, of Polson, died in the Polson Hospital Thursday morning. Mrs. Isaacs was born Jan. 29, 1893 at Harrison, Idaho, the daughter of Francis M. and Nancy W. Savage. She spent her early years and went to school in Idaho. The family moved to the Flathead in 1905, traveling by covered wagon by way of Polson and the east shore of Flathead Lake to the Creston area where they made their home, later moving to Stoner on the west Lake Shore which is now known as Lakeside. While there her father built the original Lakeside Chapel and other buildings. She attended the Flathead County schools and in March 1915, married O.V. Isaacs. From 1930 to 1945 they ranched at Browns Meadows and moved from there to California where they had resided at Springville, Turlock,

Cotati and in Clear Lake where she was preceded in death by her husband in 1976. At that time she moved back to Montana and divided her time between Kalispell and Polson. Mrs. Isaacs is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Laurence (Opal) Loveless of Polson, MT, Mrs. Tom (Ruth) Deutsch, Boulder City, Nevada, and Mrs. Bob (Shirley) Slayden, Lakeport, CA, one sister Susan Duty, Lewiston, Idaho, 4 grandchildren, 3 great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, her son Merle, 6 brothers and 1 sister. Funeral services were Monday Oct. 15 at the Weatherford Funeral Home with Rev. John L. Dutzar of the Polson Presbyterian Church officiating. Burial followed in the Conrad Memorial Cemetery.
