Dan B. Young, 25, formerly of Kalispell, died Monday near Santa Cruz, Calif., the result of a mudslide.

Young, who lived in Boulder Creek, Calif., was born March 29, 1956, the son of Ross and Dolores Huso Young. He attended Trinity Lutheran School through the eighth grade and graduated from Flat-

head High School in 1974.

He received a bachelor's degree in electronics from DeVry Institute of Technology in Tempe, Ariz. He worked as an electronics engineer for Avontec Co. in Santa Clara and was finishing work on his master's degree in electronics.

Young was active in church activities and interested in music and photography. He also was an avid skier, a marathon runner and was interested in karate.
