### NOTICE FOR PUBLICATION.

Department of the Interior, U. S. Land Office at Kalispell, Montana, February 6, 1918.

Notice is hereby given that Glenn T. Griswold, whose postoffice address is Kalispell, Montana, did, on the 22nd day of June, 1917, file in this office Sworn Statement and Application, No. 07144, to purchase the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ; SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 28, township 2, N., Range 24 W., Montana Meridian, and the timber thereon, under the provisions of the act of June 3, 1878, and acts amendatory, known as the Timber and Stone Law," at such value as might be fixed by appraisement, and that, pursuant to such application, the land and timber thereon have been appraised, the timber estimated 40,000 board feet at \$1.00 per M, and the land \$60.00; that said applicant will offer final proof in support of his application and sworn statement on the 20th day of April, 1918, before Register and Receiver of the United States Land Office at Kalispell, Montana.

Any person is at liberty to protest this purchase before entry, or initiate a contest at any time before patent issues, by filing a corroborated affidavit in this office, alleging facts which would defeat the entry.
